

Photography Brief – Friendly Footprint Youth Event

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1. Brief

The City of Bayswater is seeking expressions of interest from photographers **aged under 25 years** to document 'Friendly Footprint', a youth-led sustainability event coordinated by the City of Bayswater.

The photographer will capture attendees and volunteers engaged in a range of workshops and other activities at the event. The photographs will be used on the City's website, social media, and various other channels for promotional purposes.

2. Event Details

Sunday 4 October 2020, 10am – 4pm

3. Event Summary

Members of the City of Bayswater Youth Advisory Council will coordinate an 'open day' at Environment House in Bayswater for young people aged 12-25. Friendly Footprint will be an event for young people to learn simple and practical sustainability skills.

This will be a day of free workshops, information and activities which will focus on sharing simple practical skills to enable participants to live more sustainably. Workshops will include growing an edible garden, composting, making bees wax wraps and basket weaving. There will also be activities like a mini 'Repair Café', a clothes swap and additional smaller activities which relate to sustainability.

4. Timeframes

- **Expressions of interest must be received no later than 5pm, Wednesday 30 September 2020.**
- Photographs of the event (in high resolution .jpg format) must be submitted to the City of Bayswater by no later than Friday 9 October 2020.

5. Eligibility Criteria

Essential

- Be aged 12-25;
- Provide their own equipment, inclusive of cameras, and editing equipment and software;
- Be able to arrange their own transport to and from the event at Environment House;
- Provide a link to previous images of their work (through Dropbox or a link to a website);
- Be available for the full duration of the event; and
- Be able to deliver within the specified timeframes above.

Desirable

- Be a resident of the City of Bayswater.

6. Image Ownership

All images will become the property of the City of Bayswater.

7. Budget

The successful applicant will receive a total of \$400 (including GST) as payment. This will be paid into the applicant's nominated bank account within 28 days of images being submitted to the City.

8. Submission

Interested applicants will be required to submit an email to yac@bayswater.wa.gov.au indicating interest and capability in undertaking the project, including a short bio and a link to examples of their work (this can either be a link to a website or a Dropbox folder).
