## What goes in the recycling bin?

Items for recycling should be rinsed, clean and empty, with no lids.

- Glass bottles and jars (no lids)
- Paper (not shredded)
- · Flattened cardboard
- Aluminium and steel cans.
- Plastic bottles and containers (no lids)



## What goes in the FOGO bin?

If it didn't live or grow, it's not FOGO! If in doubt, leave it out.

- Food scraps, bones, shells
- Tea bags, coffee grounds, used tissues
- Food-soiled paper towel and cardboard
- · Compostable liners, shredded paper
- Dog poo, kitty litter
- Lawn clippings, weeds, prunings



## What goes in the general waste bin?

Items that can't be composted or recycled. Items placed in this bin will get sent to landfill.

- · Polystyrene, soft plastic
- Nappies, hygiene products
- · Long-life milk cartons
- · Disposable coffee cups
- · Coffee pods
- · Old clothing
