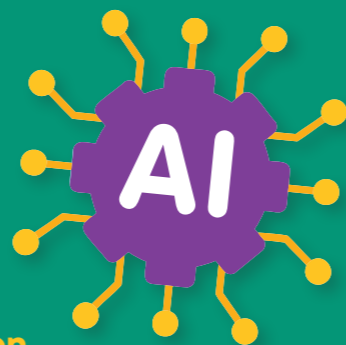

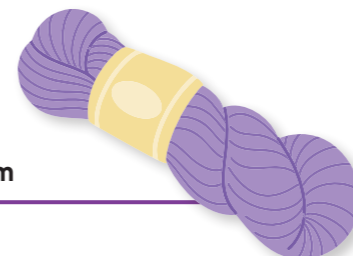

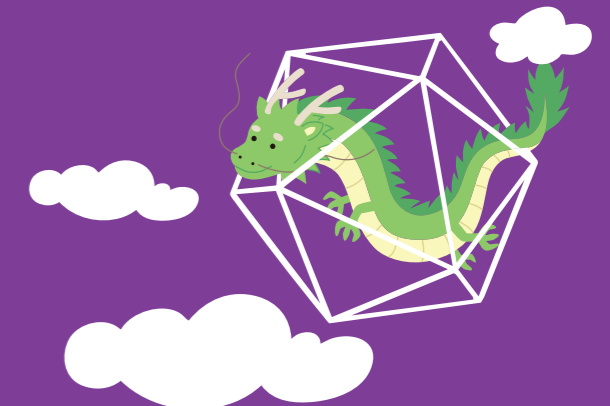
Dungeons and Dragons

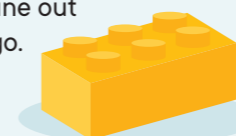
