## PROPOSED LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2024

The City of Bayswater Council previously resolved to amend the current *Local Government Property Local Law 2016,* and at the Ordinary Council Meeting on 10 December 2024 resolved to advertise the City's proposed *Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2024* for the purposes of seeking public comment.

The purpose of the *Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2024* is to amend the City of Bayswater's *Local Government Property Local Law 2016*.

The effect of the *Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2024* is to include a new clause 5.9 – "Unclaimed Items on Local Government Property" and to increase the modified penalties within the proposed local law within Schedule 1.
